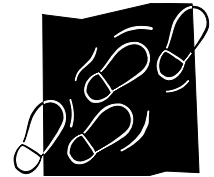

1. Unreservable lockers – we'll look at that more explicitly – good input. I think we do have that covered anyway by how the group is managed without making special settings on different lockers.
2. Yes, we agree. Every model we have considered involves short-term reservations only. They would expire after a matter of hours or a couple days at most. Any other model essentially eliminates the on-demand, shared resource.
3. If you take a close look at the numbers, I do not think this is realistic, but only time will tell.
